The Center is host to highly recognized after-school and adult programs, and is also well-known as the home to two of Madison's oldest cultural institutions, the Scottish Country Dance Club and the folk music venue, Wild Hog in the Woods Coffeehouse. Wil-Mar is a long-established 501© 3 organization which produces Southwest Wisconsin's wildly popular annual French-themed world music festival, La Fete de Marquette, and co-produces Madison's oldest and most diverse street festival, The Willy Street Fair.
